#### Overview:

The Shepherd Neame site built Mash Tun project was a challenging project due to the age & structure of the old Brewhouse, both Mash Tun materials where ingresses into the building through a small personnel door approximately 10m up off the ground.

Existing wooden Mash tuns were cut out and replacements installed in position, room to maneuver the Mash Tun sections through the Brewhouse was to a minimum. End result 2 replacement Mash Tuns in position with 0 incidents on site.
